Common to all Wanderlust Tours

An extraordinary experience will always await your clients!

On Canoe tours, wear shoes that—if they get wet—are OK.

On Cave tours, wear hiking shoes or sturdy tennis shoes, long pants and sweatshirts.

On GPS Eco-challenges, wear long pants and hiking shoes or boots.

On Snowshoe tours, dress in layers with powder pants and snow boots. Hats and gloves are needed too.

On all tours, bring a water bottle, snacks if desired and a camera to record the magnificence.

No experience is necessary to participate on any professionally guided Wanderlust Tour.

Our tours are conducted in Central Oregon's beautiful outdoors—RAIN or SHINE. Guests must dress appropriately for the weather. Dressing in layers for any trip is advised. Carry a daypack to put extra clothing in. A confirmation will always be emailed to you after our proposal is accepted.

SUMMER ITINERARIES

CANOE TOURS

Cascade Lakes Canoe Tours—half day

An exciting journey brings us deep into the heart of the rugged Cascade Range. Explore the fingers of basaltic lava, which spilled over Mt. Bachelor's 9,000-foot slopes, spewing steam as it collided with frigid mountain melt-off from the Three Sisters. Canoeing provides the ultimate experience in this area!

- Trips depart about 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. daily
- \$47 per person, \$42 per youth under 12
- Includes professional naturalist guide, transportation, canoes, all gear and instruction
- Great for kids of all ages!
- Trips run June through October
- Maximum elevation – 6,300 feet
- Tour Length – 4 hours

Moonlight Canoe Tours—evening

On a glassy lake in the heart of the Cascade Range, we'll drop in the canoes and away we go for an absolutely serene and stunning paddle under the light of the moon. At some point we will pull out onto shore for dessert and hot apple cider. Of course our guides will provide fun interpretation for the night's journey.

Guides will share fun natural and cultural history with guests during our 2-hour paddle. Dessert and coffee await our return to shore before heading home.

- Most appropriate for adults
- Trips run June through September
- Maximum elevation – 6,300 feet

Brews and Views Canoe Tours—half day or evening

Wanderlust Tours' famous Cascade Lakes Canoe Tours with the added fun of a beer tasting event! Paddle the water of a pristine mountain lake with a naturalist guide and taste various beers from one of Bend's local brewing companies with the help of their professional brew masters!

Flat water Deschutes River Canoe Tours—half day, March through May

The Deschutes and Spring rivers are two silvery ribbons that carve Sunriver's western boundary. These rivers, the earth's life-blood, provide a dramatic means to take in the best of this area. Bald eagles, native rainbow trout, and mink cavort as we roll down the river. The headwaters of Spring River prove to be just that--ancient well springs--having descended from high in the Cascades. This is relaxation at its best!

Note: Even if groups have canoed the Deschutes on their own before, this is a completely different part of the river—plus Spring River—providing a truly unique experience with a Wanderlust guide!

- Trips depart about 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. daily

CAVE, VOLCANO AND GPS ECO-CHALLENGE TOURS

Cave Tours—half day year round

Discover the hidden underground world of Central Oregon's remote lava caves with a naturalist guide! These large cool caverns are safe and fascinating! Leading groups with headlamps for all, our guides will provide in-depth interpretation on the formation of the lava tubes, the wildlife habitat inside the caves and the many uses of the caves over time from native American dwellings to cold storage for early Bend residents. Central Oregon's caves are delicate ecosystems that few have experienced in this way!

- Tours depart around 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. daily
- \$42 per adult, \$37 per youth under 12 (age minimum 5 yrs.)

Volcano Tours of Newberry National Volcanic Monument--half day

Your Wanderlust Tours guide will take you deep into the belly of an ancient volcano. At 6,300 feet you'll walk on a mountain of black glass, hike the shores of sparkling Paulina Lake through old growth hemlock forest and experience Paulina Creek's plunging waterfalls! This trip is a combination of various short, easy walks on relatively flat ground totaling just less than 2 miles.

SNOWSHOEING

Snowshoe Tours—half day

Our guide will share fun natural and cultural history while we observe animal tracks in the snow. The serenity of a snow-muffled winter forest is nothing less than astounding. We'll finish up with some hot chocolate back at the van. Call in advance for rentals of powder pants and snow boots if needed. Rated easy – 1 to 1.5 miles

- \$37 per adult, \$34 per youth under 12
- Includes professional naturalist guide, snowshoes, transportation and hot chocolate
- Kids 8 years and older welcome
- Trips run December through May
- Maximum elevation – 6,500 feet
- Tour Length –3.5 hours

Moonlight Snowshoe Tours—evening

Under the brilliant, bright moon our snowshoe trek heads into the snowy Cascade Mountains. For about 2 hours we'll kick through the white fluffy stuff. Our guide will share fun natural and cultural history while we experience the forest at night. The moon's light will guide our path to an opening where the surrounding mountains will glow under its light! We'll finish up with some hot chocolate back at the van.

HIKING TOURS

Tumalo Mountain Trek

Get ready to head into the heart of the Cascade Mountain Range, the backbone of Oregon! Our ascent will take us up 1,500 feet to Tumalo Mountain's spectacular 7,800-foot summit. This volcano sits right next to Mt. Bachelor, Broken Top and South Sister, a great spot for our guide to highlight the region's geology from what is perhaps the most impressive view of the Central Oregon Cascades. Rated challenging – 3.5 miles
We recommend this hike in the morning if it's scheduled for July or August.

- Includes professional naturalist guide and transportation
- Great for kids of all ages!
- Best time June through October
- Maximum elevation – 7,800 feet

High Desert Museum plus Benham Falls

First, at a vast lava field's edge rages **Benham Falls**. The placid Deschutes River turns torrid, yet the serenity of aspen groves along this gentle hike has a calming effect. Then, we'll embark on a visit to the riches of culture found at the world-class **The High Desert Museum**. The museum is an unexpected treasure of natural and cultural history. Your Wanderlust guide will help reveal insights to the museum's incredible displays with a **45-minute docent tour** of the Spirit of the West and then let you take in some of the live porcupine, fox, bobcat, river otter or birds-of-prey shows on your own.

- Custom departures available
- Base cost \$64 per adult, \$59 per youth under 12
- Includes naturalist guide, transportation, Museum admission
- Great for kids of all ages!
- Best time April through November
- Maximum elevation – 4,500 feet

High Desert Museum plus Lava Lands

First, we'll trek around the top of **Lava Butte** for vistas of Oregon's backbone, the Cascade Range, and 10 square miles of lava below. Then we'll embark on a visit to the riches of culture found at the world-class **The High Desert Museum**. The museum is an unexpected treasure of natural and cultural history. Your Wanderlust guide will help reveal insights to the museum's incredible displays with a **45-minute docent tour** of the Spirit of the West and then let you take in some of the live porcupine, fox, bobcat, river otter or birds-of-prey shows on your own.

- Base cost \$64 per adult, \$59 per youth under 12
- Includes naturalist guide, transportation, National Monument fee, Museum admission
- Great for kids of all ages!
- Best time April through November
- Maximum elevation – 5,000 feet
- Tour Length – 3.5 hours

Crater Lake- The Gem of Oregon

Oregon's only **National Park**, our visit begins at the Pumice Desert, a remnant of Mt. Mazama's tremendous blast. We'll next ascend the north flank of the volcano and arrive on the rim for incredible views down to Crater Lake. Several stops on the rim will give everyone great vantage points while the guide unfurls the geologic history. Wanderlust Tours can arrange lunch at the spectacular and **historic lodge** at Rim Village. We will travel the rest of the rim before heading back to Sunriver.

- Custom departures available
- Base cost \$110 per adult, \$105 per youth under 12
- Includes professional naturalist guide, lunch, National Park entrance fee and transportation
- Great for kids of all ages!
- Best time June- October
- Maximum elevation – 7,100 feet
- Tour Length – 8 hours
