- The Department of Transportation recently released updated Planning Emphasis Areas (PEAs) which are intended to be used by metropolitan planning organizations, state departments of transportation, transit agencies, and federal land management agencies in their Unified Planning Work Programs and State Planning and Research Work Programs. The notification of updated PEAs is included.
- MPOs are required to establish a Performance Based Planning and Programming framework in their Regional Transportation Plans; including tracking performance on these areas: safety, bridge and pavement condition, highway and freight reliability, emission reduction, and traffic congestion.
